*****Levels of Supervision for Specialty Procedures:**

Level 1: Staff practioner is physically present and directly involved in procedure.

Level 2: Staff practioner is physically present in the operative or procedural suite and immediately available for consultation

Level 3: Staff practioner is immediately available in facility or beeper call
